Recap:

Checking in:

- **Pond:** Going great! Two more sessions in December, then top up sessions once a year. Funding available for pond management.
- Future plans: Water testing kits, introducing new plants, kids and family activities, fixing the gate
- Meadow Patches: Freeways Trust and Val worked together to complete. FTwere great but sometimes hard to find regular activities for their group. Could ask them to come again if something suitable comes up.
- Cutting map/Cat mint: Proposed new map by Rosie. Last map was in 2015. Open to thoughts about long grass and input from volunteers about cutting map by 17th December.
